Sign-up: Register at the event. On-line registration is not available.

When: 4:00 - 6:00 PM Saturday On-Site Registration
7:00 AM Registration
8:30 A.M. rider's meeting.
9:00 Optional Parade lap.
9:15 A.M. Kidz Race
10:30 Short Course Motorcycle race. This will be a 1½ hour race for the amateur classes.
1:30 P.M. Long Course Motorcycle race. This will be a 2½ hour race for the expert classes.

Where: **Silver Beach Resort** at the west end of Rimrock Lake, a spectacular setting in the Cascade Mountains a few miles east of White Pass on Highway 12. Resort phone (509) 969-2312.

Course: Multi-wave start per NMA rules. The race course will be about 10 miles long located on the lake bed.

Gate Fee: **\$5.00 per person**, age 12 and under free.

Rider Fees: Entry - **\$50.00** for all classes except Kidz classes are **\$15.00** and Masters class (age 60+) is free.

Note: Minimum wheel size for the off-road series is 17".

Camping: Silver Beach Resort Phone 509/ 672-2500 or Rimrock Lake Resort Phone 509/ 672-2460.

Required: SPARK ARRESTOR AND ORV TAG REQUIRED. Sound test limit 98 db.

Awards: Top finishers in the AA Class will receive a cash pay-out, other classes, trophies. See FAQ.

Rules & Class descriptions: Go to www.nmaoffroad.org and click on racing then rules. Common mistakes that racers make that can result in disqualification include leaving the course to return to the pits and pitting outside of the pits. Remember, a rider must cross the finish line under a checkered flag to be counted as a finisher. **No Tear-Offs** on the lake bed. No pre-riding the course. Fueling must take place on the boards in the pits fueling area, **dead** engine and no smoking. Do not cut the course. You cannot go backward on the course. Stay out of the creek and river. Rider may have only one helper in the fueling area. Violators are subject to disqualification.

Saturday Riding: The lake bed is open to riding on days preceding the race but **stay off the marked race course.**
Important! Do not ride through the creek – huge fine.
